Curriculum

Runge Elementary School utilizes high-quality curriculum that supports student success with Bluebonnet Learning curriculum in kindergarten through 5th grade for math and reading, Bluebonnet Learning for 6th Grade Math, and Amplify Learning for 6th grade reading.

Forms of Academic Assessments

Runge Elementary has common formative assessments that every teacher gives. No matter the teacher, each child is assessed via the same assessment provided by the Bluebonnet Learning curriculum (or Amplify in 6th reading) which models each assessment after the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness or STAAR test. Previous STAAR tests are released and utilized for assessment and instruction in addition to other curriculums.
